## Activities during the year:

The Diversity & Inclusion committee planned and hosted a social hour at the WSWS Annual Meeting in Seattle in March 2025. We estimate 70-90 members attended. At this social we introduced the mission of the committee, timeline of events related to committee activity, and the committee members. There, and at the poster session, we displayed a poster that summarized the committee and asked for member input as to how we should focus our activities for 2025-2026. The same survey was also available online via Qualtrics. Results of the survey are summarized in the table below. The Diversity & Inclusion Committee officially became a standing committee at the WSWS Business Meeting.

We discussed how to go about creating a scholarship that would bring undergraduate students from diverse backgrounds to the WSWS Annual Meeting. We decided to target undergraduate students because reaching future weed scientists while young can shape their trajectory and encourage continued involvement in the Society. Efforts to implement such a scholarship are ongoing.
