## **Activities during the year:**

a. The House and Senate are rejecting the President's proposed "skinny budget" for FY 2026 in general. There are also a handful of ag research programs that received funding in the One Big Beautiful Bill Act (P.L. 119-1). Congress will need to pass a "skinny Farm Bill" by Sep. 30, 2025, or extend it again for the third year in a row.
