Committee Activities during the Year: attend annual meetings of WSWS and WSSA as well as serve on the board of directors for both societies

- As a result of an item brought up at the WSWS summer BOD meeting, the WSSA BOD voted on a motion the resulted in combining the payment of annual membership dues with payment of annual meeting registration. There will still a provision to pay only annual membership dues without meeting registration. Membership renewal and meeting registration will occur simultaneously.
- WSSA entertained 3 proposals for annual meeting management. IMI's proposal was accepted by the BOD, based on proposed cost and ease of having a single point of contact for business and meeting management.
- Transition from Allen Press to Cambridge University Press is complete.
 - After the next couple issues of Weed Technology; abstracts will no longer have an accompanying Spanish translation.
 - Still seeking some early editions of WEEDS to have added to the digital journal collection
- WSSA is currently seeking a newsletter editor and an EPA Liaison replacement for Dr. Michael Barrett.
- WSSA Graduate Student Organization presented proposal for "Graduate Student Experience"
 - o BOD had mixed opinions/reviews; no action taken
 - o Considering proposal to share cost with regional societies
- WSSA experiencing membership decline and expenses have exceeded revenue for last two years.
- Concern over declining sustaining membership as a result of buyouts and mergers.
- WSSA is entertaining proposal to change its fiscal year to better align with revenue cycle.
