## **Committee Activities during the Year:**

On Board action, contract was approved and signed with Interactive Management Incorporated of Westminster, CO. Tara Steinke will be our account representative. The contract will begin February 1 so there will be overlap with Phil Banks during preparation and duration of the Annual Meetings in Coeur d'Alene.

Contacted student travel award winners to give congratulations and initiate correspondence between students and Phil Banks for payment and service arrangements at the annual meeting.

Contacted Roger Gast regarding the inclusion of language to give brief description of Elena Sanchez in the Student Travel Award application and possibly the operating guide. He and I found the same obituary script. The Awards Committee was going to draft a statement. Participated in Scheduled Science Policy Committee conference calls. Provided comment on solicited issues, not nearly as many as early in the summer (dicamba drift from soybean fields). Extended support of favorable Ag Research Budget. Withheld support for specific endorsement or concern for Presidential Nominees as this seemed too political among some regional society Presidents and turn around time was too short to solicit input from Board.

Contacted confirmed Fellows and Distinguished Weed Scientist for congratulations and confirm intent to attend the meeting. Confirmed that a brief biography would be needed for the Proceedings.

Checked in on committees coordinating the Weed Resistance Listening Sessions in conjunction with the WSSA Resistant Plants Committee. The members involved were expected to complete increasing tasks in preparation. They performed in excellent professional manner. Reports of the sessions have been taken in very positive light.

The family of Rita Beard has donated generously to establish an Endowment in her name. Phil Banks received the gift at the end of Feb during the invasive species meetings in Washington, D.C. This Endowment will be open to contributions from individuals or organizations and will be tax deductible. An Ad Hoc committee has been established to set the Endowment articles of
